Day 4 Vancouver

Enjoy a six-hour sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore. Travel across the Lions Gate Bridge and into the Coast Mountains. Experience the Capilano Suspension Bridge and Treetops Adventure, discovering the coastal temperate rainforest and British Columbia's First Nations heritage. Next, visit Grouse Mountain (gondola admission included), the Peak of Vancouver, and take in breathtaking views of the city, ocean, and surrounding mountains. Overnight in Vancouver.

Day 5 Vancouver to Seattle

Travel in GoldLeaf Service onboard Rocky Mountaineer's new Coastal Passage route from Vancouver to the gateway to the Pacific Northwest, the "Emerald City" of Seattle. A motorcoach will transfer you from your hotel to nearby Pacific Central Station early this morning, where you will clear US customs and board your bi-level GoldLeaf dome coach for the southbound

rail journey to Seattle. After boarding, toast the voyage ahead and indulge in a delectable gourmet hot breakfast as you cross the mighty Fraser River and depart Vancouver.

Highlights include the community of White Rock as the train hugs the Pacific Coast, views of Bellingham Bay and the San Juan Islands beyond, the fields at the foot of the Cascade Mountains near Mount Vernon, the fishing fleet (and Boeing jets) of Everett, and a unique view of the Chittenden Locks linking Puget Sound to Lakes Union and Washington as the train nears Seattle.

Upon disembarking in Seattle at King Street Station, you will transfer to a motorcoach which will take you (and your luggage) to the Smith Cove Cruise Terminal at Pier 91, where you will board your cruise to Alaska. Overnight on Holland America's ms Oosterdam. B.
